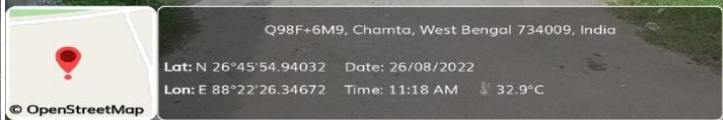
ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

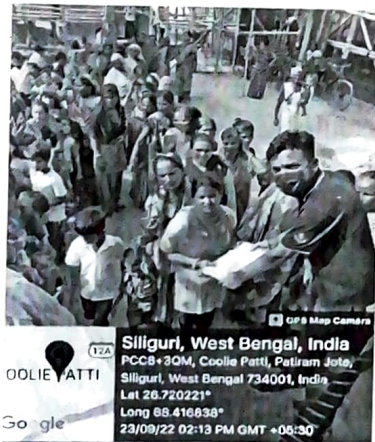
CONCLUSION:

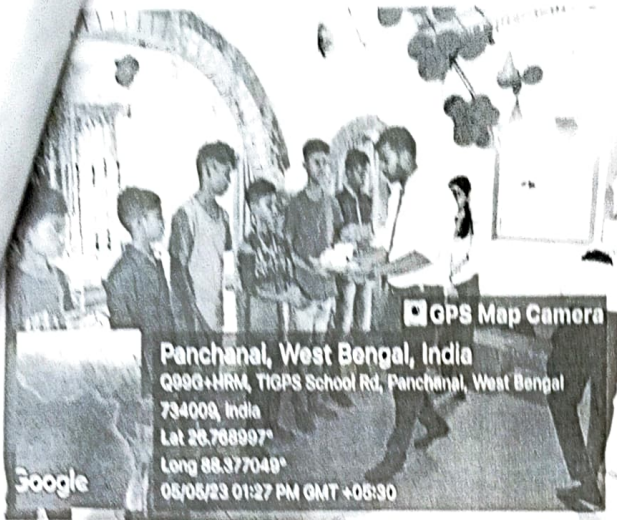
