### Japanese delegation at SNU



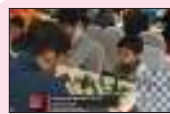

### Transformation in Educational Pedagogy

Educational pedagogy has seen vast transformation in recent years, driven by use of latest technology, shifts in societal expectations, and an evolving understanding of how students can learn best. Contrary to traditional teaching methods which focused on lectures and rote memorisation, modern pedagogy emphasises collaboration and personalised instruction.

One of the most significant changes has been the rise of student-centred learning, which places students at the heart of the learning process and encourages them to take ownership of their education. Teachers now act more as facilitators than direct instructors, guiding students to explore topics and solve problems independently. This allows children to develop critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving skills, crucial to deal with the complexities of the modern world. Flipped learning is useful for effective utilisation of the class-time to engage students in discussions and problem solving. Another major shift is the integration of technology into classrooms. Digital tools such as online learning platforms, Edtech tools, interactive flat panels and virtual reality (VR) are enhancing

student engagement, enabling the connect of class with web. The rise of blended learning, which combines in-person and online instruction, further supports flexible learning environments.

Collaborative learning is also gaining prominence. Group work, peer feedback, and project-based learning encourage students to work together and learn from one another.
